Slash Pines - TALL, LEAN and GREEN

Slash Pines are indigenous to Florida and are used for reforestation projects, timber plantations, parks and buffer plantings throughout the southeastern United States.

They grow well where the rainfall averages about 50 inches per year with a growing season of 250 days. They like a variety of acidic soils in full sun or partial shade and near lowlands, such as swamps and ponds.

Tall - Reaches heights of 80' - 100' tall

Lean - Orange/brown bark is scaly with plates

Green - Broom of needles at the end of each branch that may be 5" - 11" long

Evergreen—they keep their leaves year round.

The seeds are an important food source for wild turkeys, gray and fox squirrels.

Pine woodlands provide habitat for wildlife including whitetail deer.
